During this ceremony there will be a posting of the colors by a STARFLEET Marine Core color guard, as well as the State of Fleet video from Fleet Admiral Mandi Livingston. Our Skipper and regional co-ordinator, Brigadier Bran Stimpson, will deliver the State of the Region address, and Fleet Captain Bob Bulkeley will host a ceremony to open one of the region's time capsules. Other events at the summit include a Q&A session with author Christie Golden. Christie is author to 15 Star Trek books and is likely to talk about her new fantasy series The Final Dance. After the intermission there will be a STARFLEET Marine Corps Muster, with talks by Commandant John Roberts, and the Esprit Des Corps by Sergeant Major Kevin Severson. Captain Diane Kruse will there hold an introduction to STARFLEET presentation and will be happy to answer any questions that may arise. There will also be a CO/XO meeting for the senior officers of the region to discuss regional business. During the day there will be an intermission and three hour break to give attendees a chance to check out the items available for purchase at the silent auction, and perhaps a bite to eat. 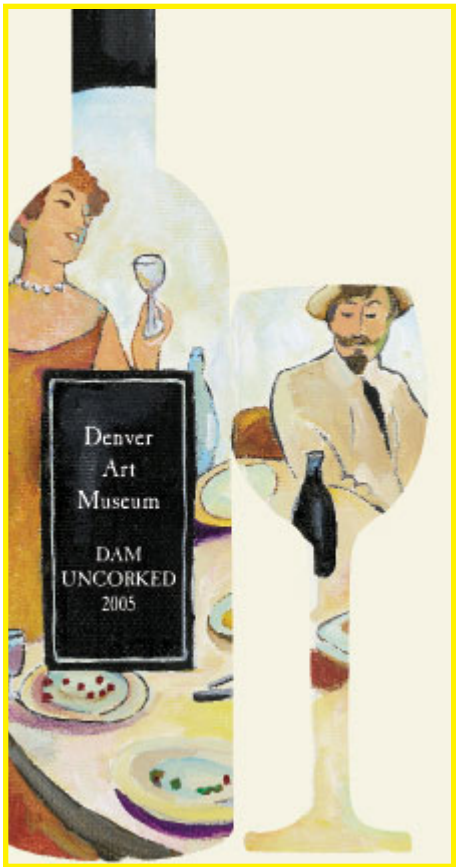
